Question and Answer

- 1) **Question:** The Terms set forth state a contract period of three (3) years with a two (2) year optional renewal. Considering the size, scope, and cost for the development of four (4) separate newsstand concessions, will the City of Atlanta consider increasing the term period to at the very least to five (5) years with a three (3) year option?

Answer: No, the City will not increase the contract period. It is the City's position that there are minimal expenses for the proponent to recoup. The City is responsible for all construction costs negotiated between the successful Proponent and the City.
