Question 1.

As discussed in the pre-bid conference, Georgia Statue to Specialty Contractors as allowed by Title 43, Chapter 41 43-41-17(f) provided exemption for duly licensed Specialty Contractors to contract work where the total scope of work to be performed is predominately of the type for which such specialty contractor is duly recognized. Please confirm that General Contractors license is not required for Prime Contractor.

Answer: An unrestricted Electrical or Utility License is an acceptable alternative. A Georgia Electrical Contractor License Class II or Georgia Utility Contractor License is required.

Question 2.

Per the project specification, the City of Atlanta DWM has identified a single subcontractor (Foxboro) for Section 17500 Distributed Control System. The specified contract will constitute a significant portion of the base bid.

Answer: No question posed.

Question 3.

Please confirm that Office of Contract Compliance goals will be calculated upon the base bid and for the purpose of this solicitation the base bid amount shall not include allowances nor Foxboro subcontract.

Answer: The EBO subcontractor participation requirements must be achieved on the base bid amount. Rationale: Allowances and alternates are not guaranteed. However, if the City elects to utilize allowances, alternates and/or change orders, the prime contractor must maintain his level of EBO subcontractor commitment for the entirety of the project.
