1.	For authoritative clarification of statements in the pre-bid conference, can a DBE that is performing the responsibility of the "Prime" constitute 100% of the 29% DBE goals for this project?
Answer	<i>Yes a DBE performing a responsibility of the Prime can constitute 100% of the 29% DBE goal.</i>
2.	If a DBE is a part of a joint venture team, is the percentage of DBE participation still calculated by the dollar amount relative to the entire fee (and can the DBE as a partner still account for 100% of the 29% DBE goal if their fee accounts for 29% of the overall fee)?
Answer	<i>Yes a DBE partner can account for 100% of the 29% DBE goal.</i>
3.	For authoritative clarification of statements in the pre-bid conference, does the required liability insurance need to be in place at the date of the proposal or can a letter and forms from an insurance provider stating that our company would qualify for the required insurance suffice?
Answer	<i>At the time of submission of its Proposal, Proponent must submit Form 5, Acknowledgement of Insurance and Bonding Requirements. The Certificate of Insurance evidencing required insurance is due when the contract is executed.</i>
4.	If DBE designation of a prime or joint venture partner is pending at the time of the proposal can that partner or a prime be considered toward the participation goals during the proposal process?
Answer	<i>Yes if a DBE is pending they can be considered, they still must complete the process to be a DBE throughout the proposal.</i>
5.	Will pre-design acoustical testing and report recommendations be within the scope of services of the design team? Will post construction acoustical testing be within the scope of the design team?
Answer	<i>Pre-acoustical testing, development of acoustical test plans and report recommendations will be within the scope of the design team. Post-construction acoustical testing will also be within the scope of the design team.</i> J
6.	Will any community outreach be required as a part of the design team's contract?
Answer	<i>It is not anticipated that any community outreach efforts will be within the scope of the design team.</i>

7.	If any historic churches in the area that fall within the sound contours are chosen for the program should a historic consultant or stained glass expert be included on the team as a sub?
Answer	<i>It is not anticipated that a historical consultant or stained glass expert will be required on the design team; however should a condition develop where these services are required then they would be added as needed.</i>
